


Pre-K-1st • Easter Lesson 28

What You Heard in the Word

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. What is the most exciting thing we remember on Easter? *Jesus rose again*.
- 2. How did Jesus' friend John, his mother, and the guards know he really died? They were there at the cross. They saw him die. The guards made sure he was dead when they pierced him with a spear.
- 3. How did the women find out that Jesus had risen from the dead? The angel told them, and they saw the empty tomb.
